English	Mathematics
<p>Reading: Students participate in weekly Guided Reading sessions that will further develop and enhance reading fluency. Students will further consolidate comprehension strategies including the super six strategies (making connections, monitoring, visualising, inferring/predicting, questioning and summarising).</p> <p>Writing: Stage 2 will be learning about the Narrative text type in Term 2. Students will plan, compose and edit narrative texts using the seven steps to writing success. Students will learn to use the correct structure, language and grammatical features of a narrative.</p> <p>Speaking & Listening: Students will participate in Speaking and Listening activities through in class fortnightly topic talks.</p> <p>Spelling & Grammar Students will explore phonemes and graphemes, and learn a variety of spelling and vocabulary concepts through the SoundWaves Spelling Program.</p>	<p>In Mathematics this term, we will be teaching various topics from the Stage 2 Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry and Statistics and Probability syllabus.</p> <p>Week 1: Addition & Subtraction Week 2, 3 & 4: Patterns & Algebra Week 5 & 6: Area Week 7 & 8: Chance Week 9 & 10: Whole number</p>

	<p>In History this semester, Stage 2 students will explore European exploration and colonisation in Australia and throughout the world up to the early 1800s. They will identify the importance of Country to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and explain the impact of British settlement in Australia.</p>
