SCIENCE	GEOGRAPHY
In Term 3, Stage 3 The science lessons will be taught by Mrs Ezekial where students will learn about the properties of solids, liquids and gases.	Stage 3 will be studying Geography throughout Semester 2. Throughout the unit students will explore countries of the Asia region and the connections Australia has with other countries across the world. Students will learn about the diversity of the world's people, including the Indigenous Peoples of other countries. Students will explore and reflect upon similarities, differences, and the importance of intercultural understanding.
