All students in the Support Unit have Individual Education Plans which cater to their abilities and needs. All programs allow students to access and demonstrate learning through multiple means.

ENGLISH	MATHS
Our English Program incorporates oral language, phonics, vocabulary, writing, reading and comprehension. Our key writing focus this term is on understanding and exploring narrative texts, using rich, quality literature. For some students, we will incorporate Colourful Semantics - a program to support spoken and written language learning across the curriculum to achieve this intended outcome.	Our maths program incorporates whole number, number operations, measurement and geometry and statistics and probability. This term students will explore the concepts and explicit strategies relating to addition and subtraction, multiplication, and division. Concepts will include 2D space, 3D objects, fractions, length, volume, mass, and data. Students engage in hands-on learning in all areas with a focus on developing number sense and fluency.
SCIENCE	CREATIVE ARTS
The science program will be dependent on the stage outcomes that your child is working towards: Group 1: In this unit, students will explore our planet Earth, stars and the moon. Group 2: In this unit, students will explore the Earth's relationship with the Sun and how the Sun, Earth and Moon interact. They will learn that the rotation of the Earth on its axis causes regular changes, including night and day and the pattern of the seasons. Group 3: In this science and technology unit, students will explore the solar system. Students will research Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples' understanding of the night sky and how scientists were able to develop ideas about the solar system through the gathering of evidence through space exploration. They will also recognise how technologies developed to aid space exploration have changed the way people live, work and communicate.	This term we will be continuing our focus on creating artworks using different mediums, prints and styles. In addition, students will participate in Music Therapy every Tuesday.
