Make Online Payments

It is now possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting <u>\$ Make a payment</u>

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). There is also a category called 'Other' this to cover items not covered in the previous headings, Other can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice.

When you access the <u>\$ Make a payment</u> you must enter:

- the students name, and
- class and reference number OR
- the students name, and
- date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system.

There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number if you are aware of them, these are optional fields OR there is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number these are not used at our school, please leave blank.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.

Dear OOSH Families,

All our current enrolled OOSH families will receive a reminder email from our admin service provider, Becklyn, in regards to re-enrolment dates. Please make note of our re enrolment dates as follows:

Priority Re-Enrolment for Existing Families -Opens: Monday, 24th October 2016 Closes: Monday, 7th November 2016

We strongly advise our current families and carers, who are seeking a permanent booking for 2017, to complete the re-enrolment well before the deadline of Monday, 7th November 2016. Please be advised that bookings are made on first come first served bases. We will still be accepting enrolments from current families after the cut-off date however, from Wednesday, 9th November 2016 we will be accepting enrolments from new families, including Kindergarten 2017 families. This may cause the permanent places to be taken up quickly. To decrease the risk of missing a place, please adhere to the booking deadlines.

Between Monday, 23rd January - Friday, 3rd February 2017, new enrolments and permanent bookings may not be processed and approved. This will allow our staff the time to focus on the large number of new Kindergarten students commencing at OOSH.
