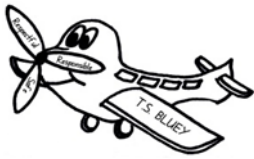

To foster a positive and inclusive school environment that promotes respectful, responsible and safe students.

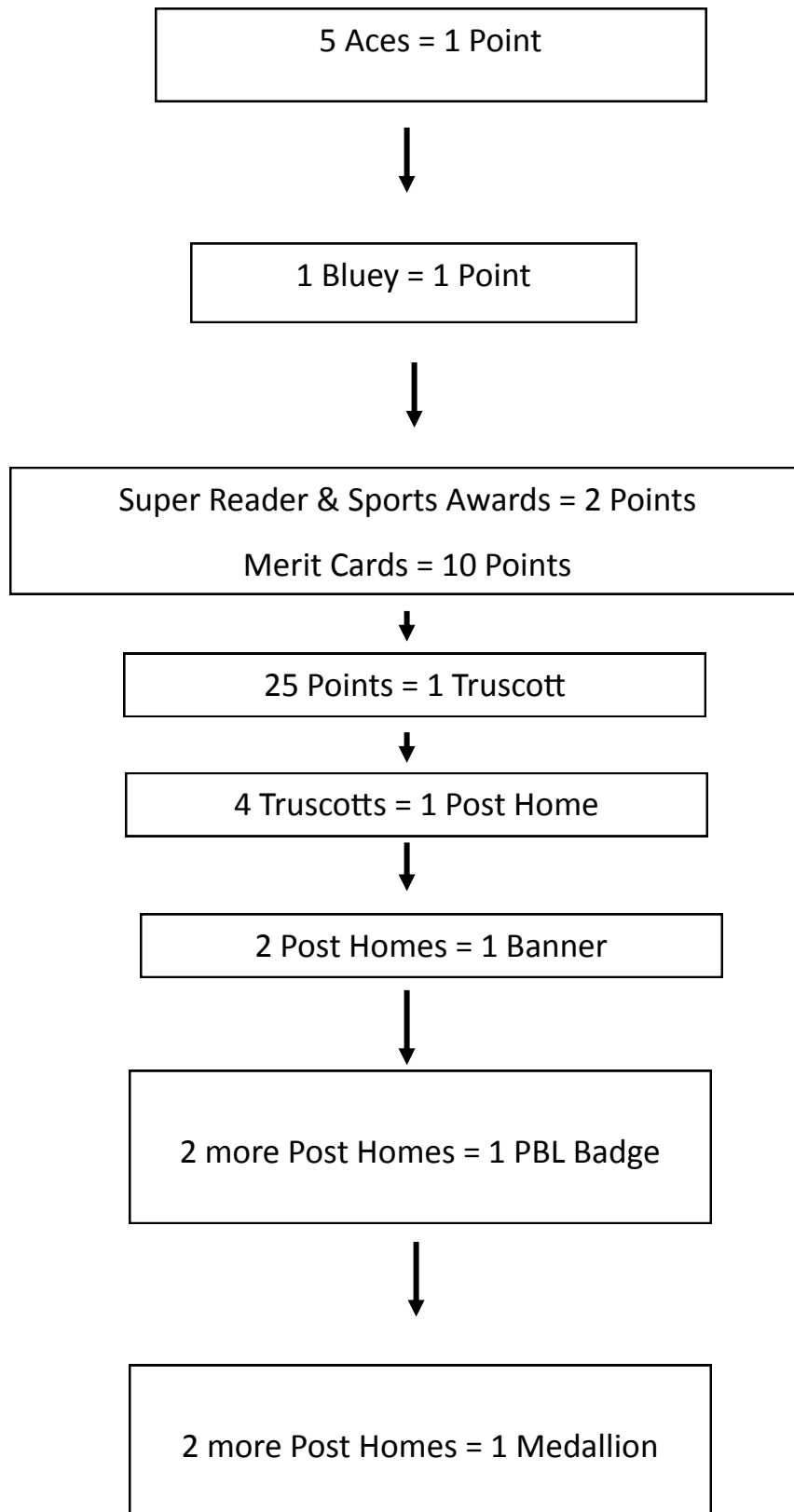
