

1ST PLACE IN SUBJECT

Cassandra Kwok achieved 1st Place in the State for Indonesian Continuers and Jessica Lu achieved 4th Place

TOP ATAR RESULTS

Kavisha Shah achieved the **top ATAR of 99.55**, Rui Jiang 99.40. 20% of students surveyed indicated ATARS above 90, 49% above 80. 73% gained entry to university.

TOP BAND RESULTS

Year 12 achieved **103 top Band results** (Distinguished Achievers with 90% or greater), with 50 students achieving at least one top band result across 32 subjects. (102 in 2014)

MANY SUBJECTS WELL ABOVE MEAN

Subjects achieving well above state mean in 2015 included Business Studies, Chemistry, English Ext, Geography, Industrial Technology, Legal Studies and Indonesian Continuers. Japanese Beginners and General Mathematics also achieved excellent results.
