Truscott Street Public School will transition to the new NSW Public Schools' finance system and a new bank account on **5th September, 2016**.

To ensure a smooth transition, there will be changes to the way we accept payments from parents and carers.

- 1. EFTPOS payments:** We will not be able to accept EFTPOS payments between **22nd August and 5th September, 2016**. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding EFTPOS payments before **22nd August, 2016**. From **6th September, 2016** EFPTOS payments will be accepted as before.
- 2. Cash and cheque payments:** Between **22nd August and 5th September, 2016**, we will also not be able to accept payments by cash or cheque as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before **22nd August, 2016**. From **6th September, 2016**, cash and cheque payments will be accepted as before.
- 3. Online payments:** We will begin to accept online payments using the Department of Education's Parent Online Payment (POP) system. More information about Online payments will be available nearer the change over.
