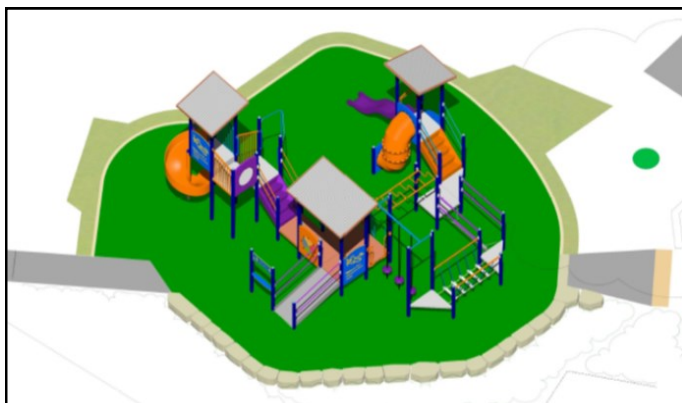
Principal's Report

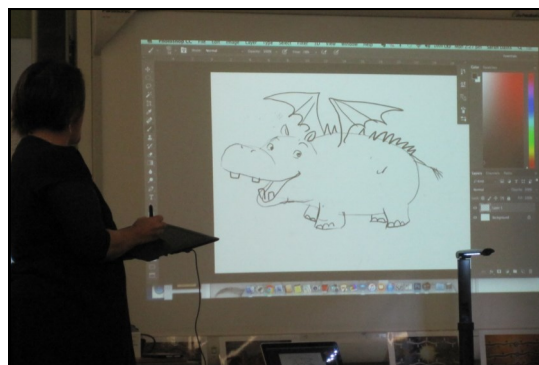

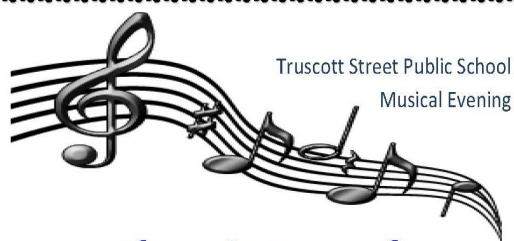



Loki D., Michael B., Jayden P. and Max T. came 4th in the junior boys relay.

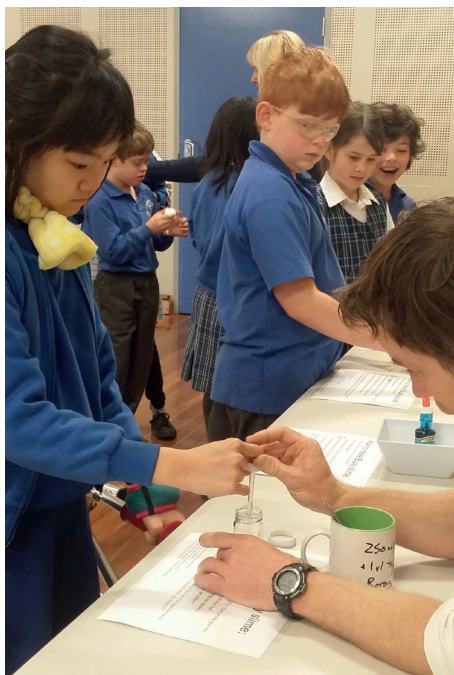
