School News**Swimming Carnival**

Our annual swimming carnival will be held this Wednesday 1st February 2017, at Lane Cove Aquatic Leisure Centre, Lane Cove. It will run from 10:00am until 2:30pm. The carnival will go ahead rain or shine.

All children in Years 3-6 will attend the carnival, as well as any Year 2 students turning 8 in 2017 who intend to enter a 50m swimming race. Year 2 students turning 8 in 2017 who are not swimming in a 50m race will not go to the pool as they are not allowed to participate in the 30m race.

Children must be turning 8 or older to compete in the Ryde Zone Swimming Carnival. There will be 30m events for students in Years 3-6 only who can competently swim 30m.

Children attending the carnival must travel by bus to allow accurate rolls to be maintained. The bus will leave school promptly at 9:30am and return by 3:25pm. If you would like to take your child home after the carnival you must tell your child's teacher.

Children are to wear sport uniform with coloured accessories or T-shirts to help cheer their team along. No crepe paper or streamers are allowed at the pool.

Canteen News

There are a number of things to note with the school canteen in 2017. We undertook a price review over the summer as some suppliers have increased their items. We have endeavoured once again to keep any price changes to a minimum. Please note the following changes:

Canteen will open on Thursday 2nd Feb due to the swimming carnival on Wednesday.

As per the canteen survey in late 2016, there will be a handling fee of 30 cents for all orders purchased across the counter. This is due to the increased staff time to reconcile these orders with the Flexi-school orders. There will no longer be a bag charge.

Wedges and nuggets are now only sold in packs of 3 at \$2.20 per bag of 3 nuggets and \$2.50 per bag of 3 wedges.
