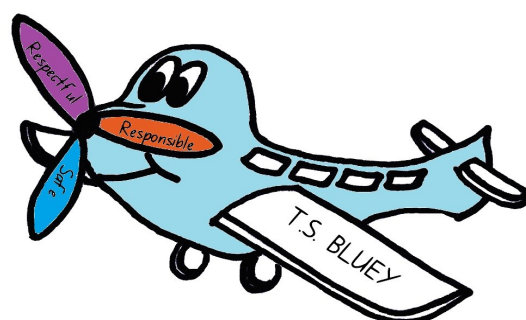

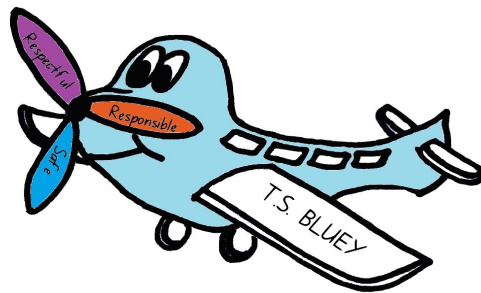

Carols Night—Save The Date

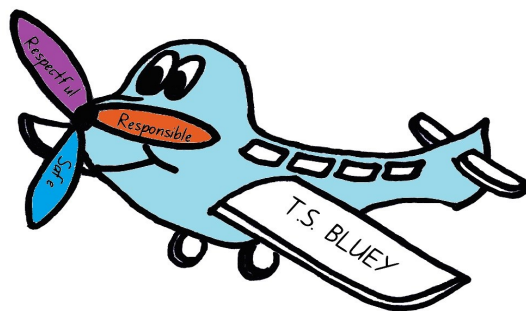
