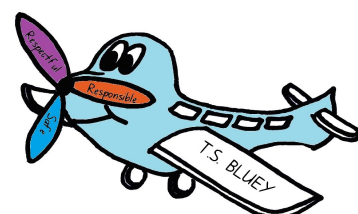

End of Summer PSSA

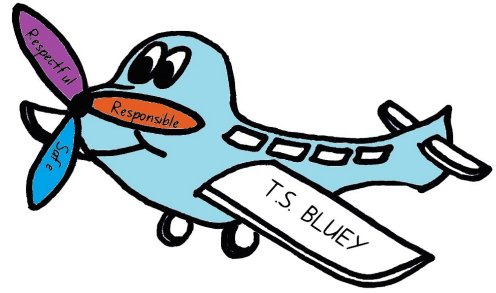

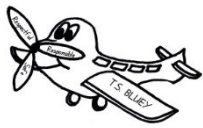
Positive Behaviour for Learning
