DESCRIPTION OF VOLUNTARY POSITIONS 2017

P&C EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

P&C PRESIDENT:	Responsible for overseeing the duties of the Executive and Committees and ensuring the successful outcome of all P&C ventures. Maintaining contact with the needs of the School through regular liaison with the Principal. Chairing monthly P&C meetings, attending School Council and sub-committee meetings as necessary; representing the P&C at School and community functions and liaising with the Executive, Principal and various sub-committees.
P&C VICE PRESIDENT (2):	Chair meetings or undertake other duties in absence of President. May also be required to assist/ liaise with other sub-committees.
P&C SECRETARY:	Responsible for taking minutes of monthly P&C meetings, dealing with incoming correspondence.
P&C TREASURER:	Responsible for the preparation of financial records of the P&C, banking, payment of expenses and presentation of financial report to monthly P&C meetings. Needs to be able to attend School occasionally to collect money and invoices.

CANTEEN COMMITTEE:

COMMITTEE	Canteen committee members are required to assist the P&C and the Canteen
MEMBERS:	Supervisor in the overall direction and management of the canteen.
CANTEEN TREASURER:	Responsible for financial supervision of the canteen, payment of accounts and wages, maintaining financial records for Canteen and recording of petty cash.

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE (OOSH):

PRESIDENT:	Stay in touch with what is happening from day to day in order for the Centre to run efficiently. Convene and control meetings, liaise with Director and committee members. See that all statutory regulations and the Centre's own rules are observed.
VICE PRESIDENT:	Assist the President where necessary and run meetings in the absence of the President.
SECRETARY:	Record minutes of committee meetings.
TREASURER:	Liaise with external administrator and review quarterly accounts. Monitor debtors.
ACCREDITATION OFFICER:	Work with Director and OOSH committee to ensure Centre passes accreditation.

OTHER ROLES:

UNIFORM SHOP:	Control buying and selling of new and used uniforms as required. Must be available to open the shop one morning or afternoon per week at a pre-arranged time. Report to

MOTHERS/ FATHERS DAY STALL:	Oversee and help in the running of non-profit making School events such as the Mothers and Father's day stalls.
PUBLICITY:	Working with the Principal, to be responsible for establishing and maintaining a high profile for the School community by media and other avenues. Person is also responsible (with the President) for writing any appropriate "P & C News" items that are included in the School newsletter. Report to P&C meetings.
GROUNDS:	Co-ordinate and oversee the installation and maintenance of gardens around the School and arrange garden working bees. Report to P&C meetings.
BAND COMMITTEE:	Two or three people, including a Co-ordinator and Treasurer, to liaise with the Band Conductor; be responsible for general organisation of band, rehearsals and performances, allocate and maintain instruments. One committee member to report to monthly P&C meetings.
CLASS PARENT CO- ORDINATOR:	Overall organisation of all class parents.
