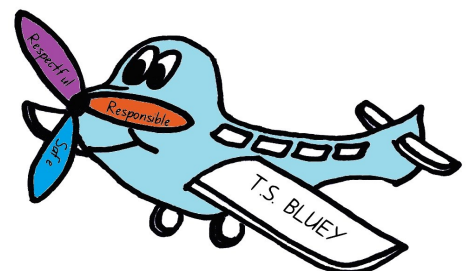


Information Breakfast

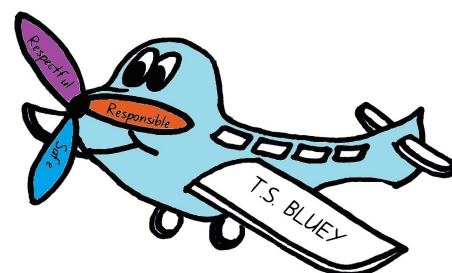

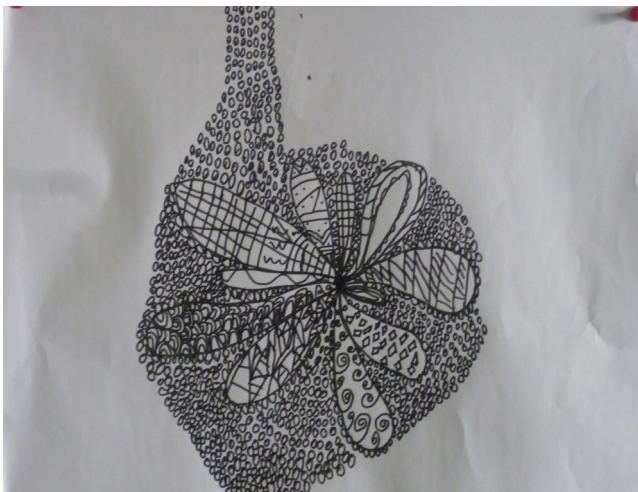

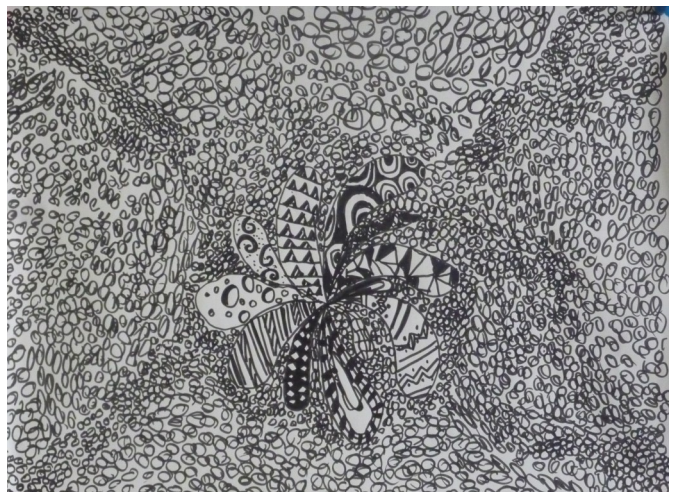
