Staff Update

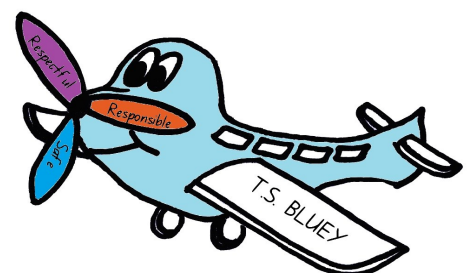
As of Friday 16th June I will be on leave until the end of term. During my absence Michelle Shannon will be relieving Principal.

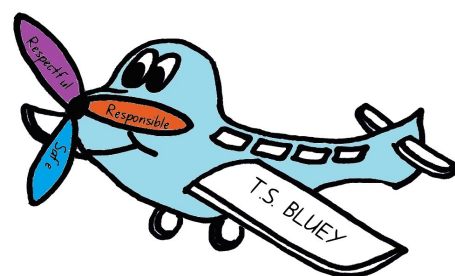
Canteen News

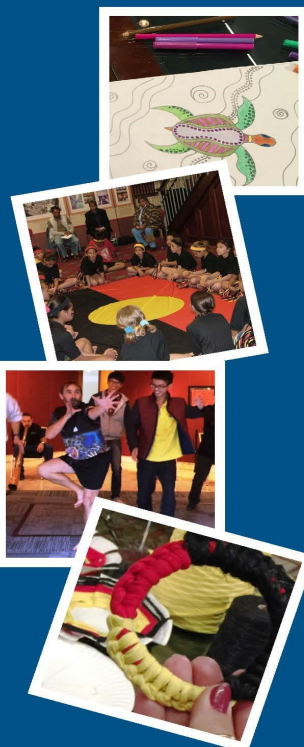

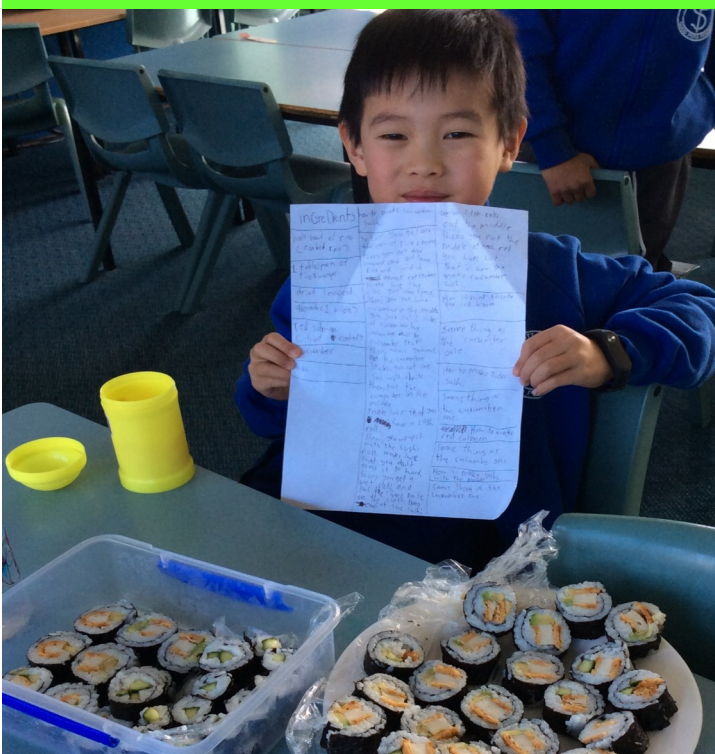
