At a recent P&C meeting, we discussed the issue of parking. We are concerned about the increase in traffic around the immediate perimeter of the school and that parking when dropping/picking up students has become an issue. It has been noticed that the workers at the construction site on Epping Rd and others travelling by public transport are using streets surrounding the school for parking. This is causing congestion and safety issues especially at drop off and pick up times.

We wish to approach the council to highlight our concerns and to ask them to consider changes to parking restrictions to make it easier and safer for parents / grandparents / others dropping / collecting children to find a spot for the time they need one. 




