There are an increasing number of parents who park in the teacher car parks. There are three car entries into the school. Two of these are *teacher only car parks*. There have been times when teachers have been either blocked in and couldn't leave or they couldn't get to their spots because some parents chose not to park on the street.

The other car entry is for cars with *access mobility permits*. This is for our families in the support unit to drop off and pick up their children who use wheelchairs. This area is not for anyone else to park in. If you are picking up and dropping off at OOSH please park in the street.

Last week a parent parked dangerously on the footpath to save walking a few extra metres. Please consider the safety of our students and park legally around our school.

I understand that parking on the street is difficult at times. There was a link to a survey for parents to complete in last week's newsletter so that council can be made aware of the issues with parking at our school.

Also no teacher car park is for *pedestrian access*. Please walk the extra few metres to enter and exit the school through the appropriate gates to ensure the safety of your child and our students.

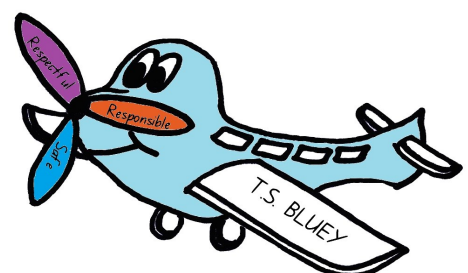

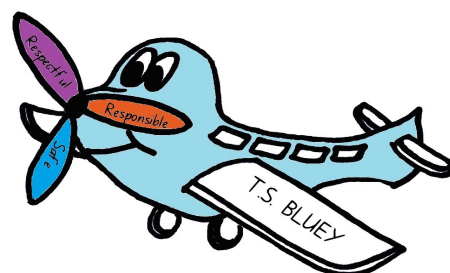

On Thursday the SRC has organised a mufti day to raise money for Stewart House.

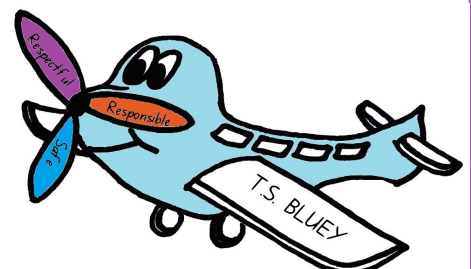
**Date:** Thursday, 29th June, 2017.

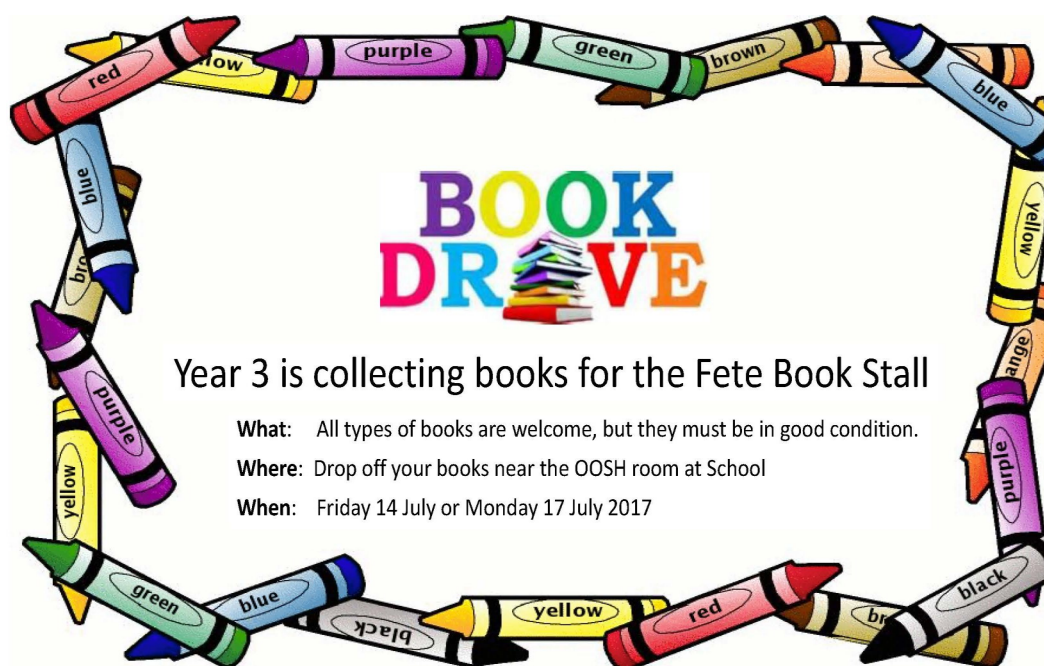

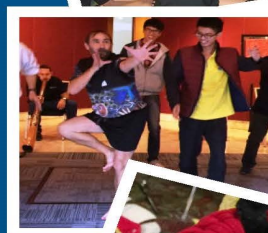
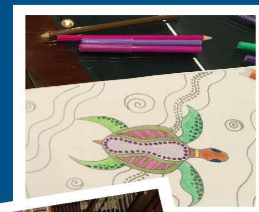
