There is a disabled car space near the Support Unit and to use this a disabled parking permit must be displayed. No other cars should be in this area as it is a major thoroughfare for our students, particularly those utilising the OOSH service.

Last Wednesday saw a number of our students performing, before a very appreciative audience, as part of our Education Week open morning. Congratulations to all our performers and their dedicated teachers on such an outstanding effort. It was the very first performance for our K-2 choir and they were very impressive indeed. ### Jump Rope for Heart

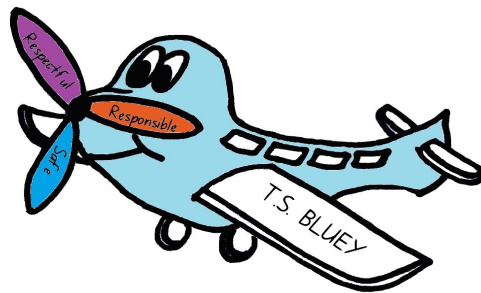
