Jump Rope for Heart

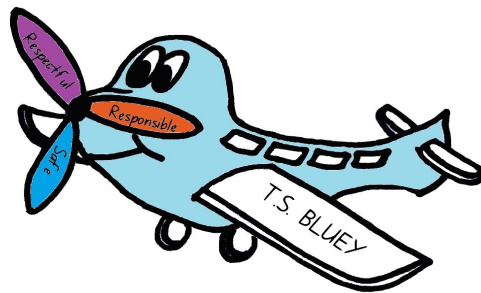

- 1st for all field events. (There is a qualifying height for high jump to attend zone.)

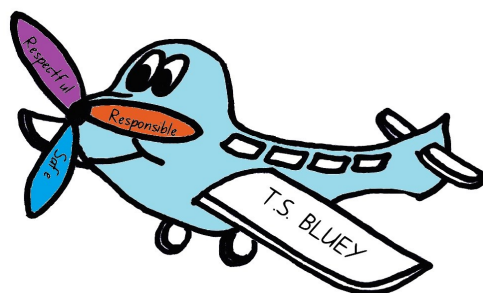

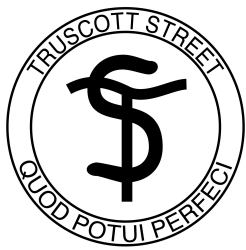
