Soccer



Australians do not eat enough fruit and vegetables. The results from the 2014-2015 National Health Survey showed that only 5.1% of both children and adults met the dietary guidelines for the number of serves of fruit and vegetables.

This means that almost **95% of the Australian population is not eating enough fruit and vegetables** which can have widespread implications on our health and wellbeing. And it's likely that most Australians are not even aware of the problem.

We can, and need to, eat more fruit and vegetables!

This year's **Fruit & Veg Month – 'Get Loud for Fruit & Veg!**' is aimed at students encouraging other children, their families and their communities to **eat more fruit and vegetables**. With your support, we hope our students (and the whole school community) **develop healthy eating habits** that last well beyond the month of activities.

As a whole school we will be participating in educational healthy eating activities in the classroom and encouraging families to **pack healthy lunches for school**. 
Fete News
