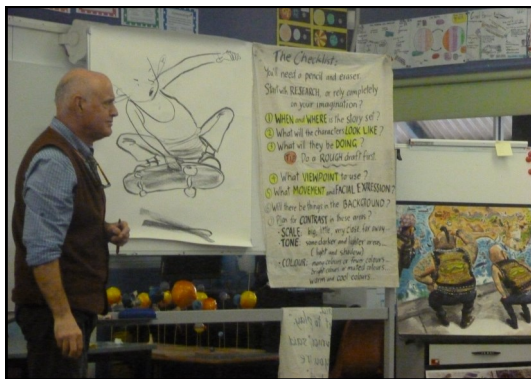
Earn and Learn

Breaghna W, Lara M, Lilly F and Chloe O came 7th in the finals of the senior girls relay.

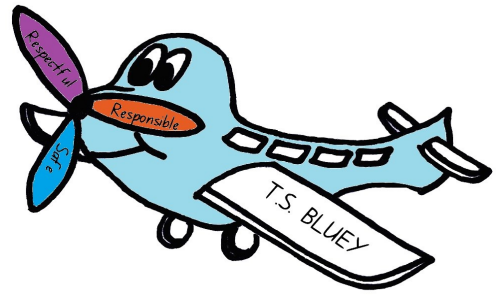

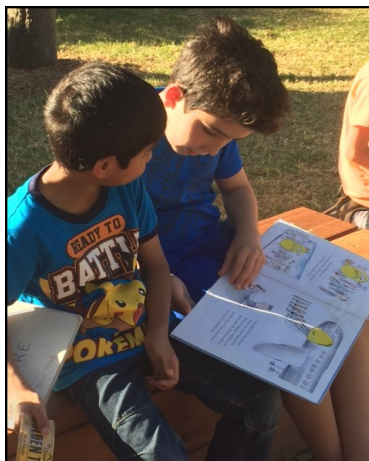

Letterbox drop - looking for letterbox volunteers

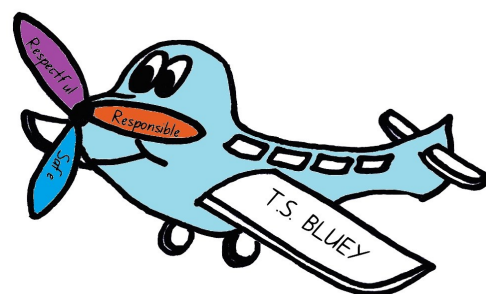

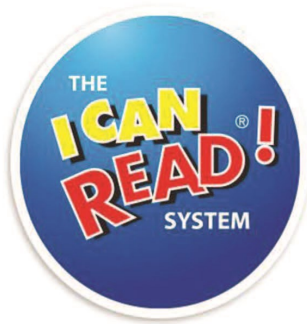

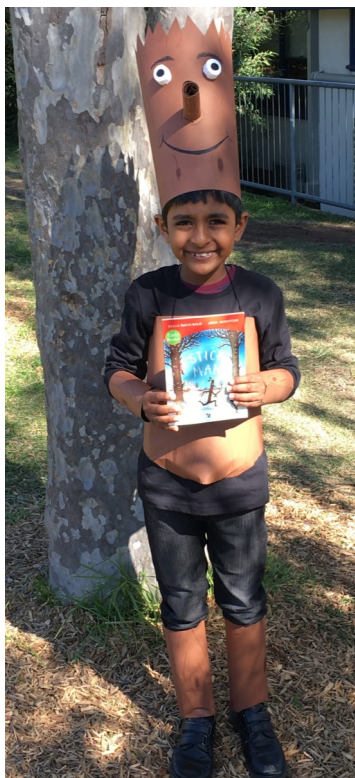
