Earn and Learn



Fete Very Special Visitor

Simone Kennedy will be our very special visitor to the Fete. Simone is a Paralympic Silver Medalist and a Para-Cycling Track World Champion and she is a former student of Truscott Street PS!

She was born in London, England on 4 January 1994 and moved with her family to Ryde when she was 2 years old. She attended Truscott Street PS from 1999 to 2005. Simone has left hemiplegia, a form of cerebral palsy. Her high school teachers (Tara Anglican School for Girls) encouraged her to become involved in a disability sport and she started cycling when she was 15 years old.

Simone is a two time Paralympian competing in London 2012 and Rio 2016, winning a Silver medal in London. She became a dual Para-Cycling Track World Champion in 2012 and regained her C3 3km Track World Champion Title earlier this year in Los Angeles, USA. She is currently representing Australia in the 2017 World Para-Cycling Road Championships in Pietermaritzburg, South Africa.

Simone will officially open the Fete at 11.00am on the Main Stage, alongside John Alexander OAM, MP, Member for Bennelong. Simone will stay after the opening to meet visitors and have her Paralympic Silver Medal and World Championship Gold Medals on show. She will also bring her rainbow jersey which was presented to her after she became a World Champion.

Simone is very excited about visiting her primary school and looking forward to meeting lots of our current students and speaking about her wonderful experiences representing Australia.
