
#### **Enrolments 2018**





#### **Special Visitor Simone Kennedy**

Simone Kennedy has just returned home after competing in the 2017 World Para-Cycling Road Championships in Pietermaritzburg, South Africa. Simone came 5th in both the Women's C3 15km Time Trial and the 48km Road Race. She was very happy with both of her races as her times were faster this year, compared to her times two years ago in the Para-Cycling Road World Cup. The conditions in Pietermaritzburg were extremely tough and all of her competitors were very strong riders. Simone is 23 years old and she is still a few years away from reaching her peak as a cyclist.

Simone is happy to be home again and can't wait to meet our current students and families at the Fete. Make sure you visit Simone after the official opening - you can find her near the buddy bench where she will be available for a chat and to sign autographs.

When all the teachers read it they asked me if I wanted to be a judge in the annual talent show!!
- **Q.** Did you ever represent Truscott Street in a sport?
- **A.** A highlight for me was representing Truscott Street at the Zone Swimming Carnival, when I was either in Year 5 or 6. This was an able bodied competition.






