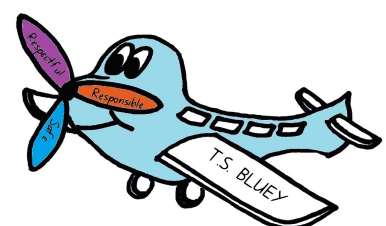
Raffle tickets need to be returned ASAP.
